Justification:

Our proposed changes seek to enhance the learning experience of Photography minors. In our current Photography Minor we determined an art history course specific to photography was needed, but have determined that we do not have the resources or faculty expertise to meet the demand for such a course. We have also determined that many of the studio courses in Photography offer ample review of 20th and 21st century practices as a way to frame both projects and discussions. A practicum experience would be much more beneficial to students, as it will offer them the opportunity to develop their portfolios and their identity as photographers in the context of contemporary practice. We have determined that this change in requirements will keep the course within the standards established by the National Association of School of Art and Design (NASAD)
